<u>Policy Discussion and Vote</u>: Should KWBTS condominium owners, who opted out of their original opportunity to participate in the NIP, be allowed to participate in the final phase of the NIP at KWBTS? Or should they have to wait until all eligible participants (including single-family homes) have had an opportunity to participate? The Committee discussed the pros and cons of the proposal at length. Peter Horton made a motion to approve; Marlene Durazo seconded the motion.

<u>Motion</u>: For KWBTS as a whole, hold-outs will be offered the opportunity to participate during the last design phase of KWBTS, if funds are available, but under no circumstances will we go back to KWBTS after we leave (i.e., we will not remobilize at KWBTS).

The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Noise Hotline and Contact Log: Deborah Lagos reviewed the Noise Hotline Log

<u>AirNAV.com</u> for KEYW: Deborah Lagos pointed out several items in the AirNAV database for EYW, including the new runway dimensions, displaced threshold, TORA, TODA, ASDA, and LDA. Richard Strickland explained that he had obtained FAA approval for the additional 274 feet for departures on Runway 09. Deborah went on to point out the noise abatement information included under "Additional Remarks."
